On January 10, 2013, Governor Patrick signed into law Massachusetts General Law chapter 71, section 38R, An Act Relative to Background Checks. The law requires all public school employees in Massachusetts to submit to fingerprint-based state and national criminal background checks.

School volunteers and subcontractors/laborers commissioned by schools to perform work on school grounds may need to submit their fingerprints for the state and national checks if asked to do so, and they must continue to submit state CORI checks.

Fingerprinting steps:

1. Go to the above website and click on Massachusetts.
2. Click on Online Scheduling or call 866-349-8130. The fee is \$55.00 for licensed educators and \$35.00 for all other personnel. When scheduling your appointment, you will need to use one of the following *Provider Identification Numbers*:

3. Make note of your registration confirmation number, which you will need to bring with you to your scheduled appointment, along with an approved form of identification.
4. Go to your scheduled appointment. You will be given a receipt, which has a unique tracking number on it. This receipt needs to be sent to Brigitte Walsh at Central Office.
5. The results from your criminal record check are sent to MA DCJIS for review. Once this step is completed, the final results are then sent to the School District.
