The Millville Board of Health will be offering the 2009 H1N1 Nasal Vaccine and H1N1 Injectable Flu Vaccine to students in **grades K through 8 for Millville residents only.** **Proof of residency will be required.** **Date of clinic to be held on:**

**Saturday, December 5, 2009**  
**Millville Town Hall**  
**8 Central Street**  
**Millville, MA 01529**  
**9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon**

The Nasal Mist Vaccine will be used at this clinic unless otherwise noted below. \*

**\*The Millville Board of Health would like to vaccinate as many as possible. Therefore, the Injectable Vaccine will be saved for individuals with underlying conditions who cannot receive the Nasal Mist. There will be no exceptions.**

**The Board of Health has only a limited supply and this clinic will be held on a first come, first serve basis.**

Children under the age of (10) must receive (2) doses at least a month apart. This dose for many will be a (1<sup>st</sup>) dose in a series of (2). If your child had already received their (1<sup>st</sup>) dose, make sure this (2<sup>nd</sup>) dose is not less than a month apart. If a parent or legal guardian is not present at the clinic, a Consent Form must be filled out and brought with your child or your child **will not** receive the vaccine. Please contact the Millville Board of Health to obtain a Consent Form, if one is needed. The Consent Form can only be filled out by a parent or legal guardian.
